At Treefrog Technology Group, we understand above all else that maintaining our customers trust is a serious and ongoing commitment. This Privacy Statement describes our Treefrog practices and how we strive to inform you of the data privacy, security practices and technologies we've put in place to ensure our protection of your information.

This Privacy Policy describes how we collect and use information that you (the Customer) may provide us in connection with your use of the Foundation Platform Software, including Beta, Trial and Full Subscriptions, Websites and all Supporting Services including Professional Services, Product Support, Training, Marketing and Advertising practices.

Please read this Privacy Statement carefully to learn how we may collect, use, share or otherwise process information relating to individuals ("Personal Data"), and content (data). This policy describes your rights and choices regarding our processing of your Personal and Company related content supplied to us.

AGREEMENT DEFINITIONS

Treefrog Technology Group (herein referred to as "Treefrog", "TTG", or "Us") have systems, websites and services related to the Foundation Platform Software (herein referred to as "Foundation", "Foundation Platform", "Foundation Platform Software", "Foundation Platform Services" "FPS", "Foundation Platform Ecosystem", or "Foundation Professional Services") which means the products and services that are ordered by You and made available by Us via the customer login and/or other web pages designated by Us, including associated offline components. "Foundation Platform", "Foundation Platform Software", and "Foundation Platform Services"

"Foundation Platform Software" means any of the modules within the Foundation Platform Ecosystem and the support structures and code required to host and provision them.

"Foundation Professional Services" means additional licensed services offered by TTG including but not limited to Foundation Onboarding Services, Foundation Support Services and Foundation Integration Services.

"Licensee", "You" or "Your" means you as an individual, or the company or other legal entity for which you are accepting this Agreement on behalf of, including any users whom you add to the software under your Subscription Licenses.

"Treefrog", "TTG", "We," "Us" or "Our" means the Treefrog Technology Group, and any of its affiliates, or subsidiaries.

"Users" means the individual customer representatives who are authorized by You to use the Foundation Platform, for whom License to Foundation Platform Software and Services have been ordered, and who have been supplied user identifications and passwords by You (or by Us at Your request). Users include but are not limited to Your employees, consultants, contractors and agents, under you direct control. User's not under your direct control such as Brokers, intermediaries, or independent 3rd party associations are prohibited from using your User Subscription licenses in any manner.

"Your Content" with respect to Foundation Platform Software and Foundation Platform Professional Services shall mean all electronic data, Your supplied Algorithms, Your custom integration code or data submitted by You to the Purchased Services.

This Privacy Statement applies to the following processing activities:

- Visiting the Foundation Platform software
- Visiting TTG or Foundation Platform websites which display or link through to this Privacy Statement;
- Visiting our offices;
- Receiving communications from us, including emails, texts or fax;
- Registering for any of our events;
- Signing Contracts, Subscriptions, and Service Orders.
- Participating in community and open source development.

Foundation Platform and related Services is a cloud based on-demand web application that runs on the Amazon Web Services platform. When applications and web services are provided by us and the application or web page links to this Privacy Statement, this Privacy Statement applies.

Foundation Platform Services running on the Amazon Web Hosted Cloud Services are provisioned as a Single tenancy architecture, unique and separate from all other clients, ensuring Your personal data and your application Foundation Platform Application Content is not shared or accessible to anyone without the proper credentials.

On occasion Our Foundation Platform web application modules and our websites may contain links to other websites, applications and services maintained by third parties. The information practices of such other services are governed by the third-party privacy statements, which we encourage you to review to better understand those third parties' privacy practices.

Important: Copyright and non-exclusive license

- a) TTG claims no copyright or other ownership rights in the Content Licensees uploads to the Foundation Platform Service.
- b) By uploading or otherwise providing Content into the Foundation Platform Service You grant to TTG a non-exclusive, royalty-free, paid-up right and license to use, reproduce, display and distribute such Content in connection TTG's provision of the Services to such persons as required to provide the service or to whom you may authorize.
- c) You hereby represent and warrant that you have all intellectual property and other rights necessary concerning any Content posted by You on the Foundation Platform Service or TTG Websites.
- d) TTG does not pre-screen Content, but TTG has the right (but not the obligation) to remove any Content or accounts containing Content that we determine in our sole discretion are unlawful, offensive, threatening, libelous, defamatory, pornographic, obscene or otherwise objectionable or Content that violates the intellectual property of any third party or these Terms of Service.
- e) You understand and agree that TTG cannot be responsible for the Content posted on some Foundation Platform related services (e.g. Chat forums, blog comment post, Twitter feedback, etcetera) and you may be exposed to objectionable materials. You agree to use the Foundation Platform and related Services at your own risk.

- f) By submitting comments, feedback, bug reports or product suggestions to TTG you acknowledge and agree that TTG is free to use these ideas and concepts that you provide for any purpose without any compensation to you.

Personal Data we collect directly from you

The Personal Data that we collect directly from you may include the following:

- if you express an interest in obtaining additional information about our services, request customer support, use our "Contact Us" or similar features, register to use our websites, sign up for an event or webinar, or download certain content, we generally require you to provide us with your contact information, such as your name, company name, address, phone number, email address or username and password;
- if you make purchases or register for an event, we may also require you to provide us with financial information and billing information, such as billing name and address, credit card number, or bank account information;
- if you attend an event, we may, upon your consent, scan your attendee badge which may provide us with your name, title and company name, address, country, phone number and email address;
- if you register for an online community that we host, we may ask you to provide a username, photo and/or biographical information, such as your occupation, social media profiles, company name, and areas of expertise;
- if you use and interact with our websites, we automatically collect log files and other information about your device and your usage of our websites through cookies, web beacons or similar technologies, such as IP-addresses or other identifiers, which may qualify as Personal Data (view the "What device and usage data we process" section below);
- if you visit our offices, you may be required to register as a visitor and to provide your name, email address, phone number, company name and time and date of arrival.

Personal Data we collect from other sources

We may also collect information about you from other sources and combine this information with Personal Data provided by you. This helps us to update, expand and analyze our records, identify new opportunities, and create more tailored module features to provide services that may be of interest to you.

In particular, we may collect Personal Data from the following sources:

- Business contact information, including mailing address, job title, email address, phone number, 'intent data' which is web user behaviour data, IP addresses, social handles, LinkedIn URL and custom profiles from third party data providers for the purposes of focusing content delivery of most value to you and our internal profiling;

Device and usage data, we may process.

We use common information-gathering tools, such as log files, cookies, web beacons and similar technologies to automatically collect information, which may contain Personal Data, from your computer or mobile device as you navigate our websites or interact with email we have sent you.

For Foundation Platform Software and our Foundation Platform websites we may use your specific machine IP address and VPN credentials to ensure a highly secure connection with You and the Foundation Platform environment.

Log Files

As is true of most web hosted applications and websites we may from time to time gather certain information automatically via log files. This collected information may include your Internet Protocol (IP) address (or proxy server), device and application identification numbers, your location, your browser type, your Internet service provider and/or mobile carrier, the pages and files you viewed, your searches, your operating system and system configuration information, and date/time stamps associated with your usage.

This information is used to ensure your dedicated Foundation Platform software is being accessed from the regions and IP addresses that are within the scope of the security protocols that you help establish during the Foundation Onboarding process. This collection of required information helps Us to guarantee the Web application and website security and continued proper functioning.

Cookies, web beacons and other tracking technologies

We may use cookies and similar technologies such as web beacons, tags and JavaScript from time to time, alone or in conjunction with cookies to compile information about usage of our Foundation Platform websites and interaction with emails from us.

When you visit our websites, our servers or an authorized third party (Google Analytics) may place a cookie on your browser, which can collect information, including Personal Data, about your online activities on our site over time. Cookies allow us to track overall usage, determine areas that you prefer, make your usage easier by recognizing you and providing you with a customized experience.

We may use both session-based and persistent cookies. Session cookies exist only during one session and disappear from your computer when you close your browser software or turn off your computer. Persistent cookies remain on your computer or device after you close your browser or turn off your computer. You can control the use of cookies at the individual browser level, but if you choose to disable cookies, it may limit your use of certain features or functions on our websites or services. To opt-out from tracking by Google Analytics, please use the specific opt-out mechanism as indicated further below.

We also may use web beacons on our websites. For example, we may place web beacons in marketing emails that notify us when you click on a link in the email that directs you to one of our websites. Such tracking technologies are used to operate and improve our websites and email communications and track the clicking of links or opening of emails.

The following sets out how we use different categories of cookies and similar technologies, as well as information on your options for managing the settings for the data collection by these technologies:

All cookies placed by TTG and listed above expire after 12 months.

Opt-Out from the collection of device and usage data

You may opt-out from the collection of device and usage data (see "What device and usage data we process" section above) by managing your cookies at the individual browser level. Please note, however, that by blocking or deleting cookies and similar technologies used on our websites, you may not be able to take full advantage of the website functions and services.

While some internet browsers offer a "do not track" or "DNT" option that lets you tell websites that you do not want to have your online activities tracked, these features are not yet uniform and there is no common standard that has been adopted by industry groups, technology companies or regulators. Therefore, we do not currently

commit to responding to browsers' DNT signals with respect to our websites. Treefrog takes privacy and meaningful choice seriously and will make efforts to continue to monitor developments around DNT browser technology and the implementation of a standard.

Social Media Features

Our websites may use social media features, such as the Facebook “like” button, the “Tweet” button and other sharing widgets (“Social Media Features”). You may be given the option by such Social Media Features to post information about your activities on a website to a profile page of yours that is provided by a third-party social media network in order to share with others within your network. Social Media Features are either hosted by the respective social media network or hosted directly on our website. To the extent the Social Media Features are hosted by the respective social media networks, the latter may receive information that you have visited our website from your IP address. If you are logged into your social media account, it is possible that the respective social media network can link your visit of our websites with your social media profile.

Foundation Platform does not currently allow you to log in to certain of our websites using sign-in services such as Facebook Connect or Google plus.

Your interactions with Social Media Features are governed by the privacy policies of the companies providing the relevant Social Media Features.

Telephony log information

If you use certain service features, we may also collect telephony log information (like phone numbers, time and date of calls, duration of calls, SMS routing information and types of calls), device event information (such as crashes, system activity, hardware settings, browser language), and location information (through IP address, GPS, and other sensors that may, for example, provide us with information on nearby devices, Wi-Fi access points and cell towers).

Purposes for which we process Personal Data and the legal basis on which we rely

Providing access to our secure web applications (Foundation Platform) and any User functions on our websites such as Contact Us or blog comments, posting to discussion boards

- We will process your Personal Data to the extent that it is necessary for the performance of our contract with you for the use of our Applications and websites and to fulfill our obligations under the applicable terms of use/service; where we have not entered into a contract with you, we base the processing of your Personal Data on our legitimate interest to operate and administer our websites and to provide you with content you access and request (e.g., download of certain content from our websites, request a demo, submit an request etcetera);

Promoting security of our websites:

- We will process your Personal Data by tracking use of our websites, creating aggregated, non-personal data, verifying accounts and activity, investigating suspicious activity, as well as violations of and enforcement of our terms and policies, to the extent this is necessary for the purpose of our legitimate interests in promoting the safety and security of the systems and application used for our websites, and protecting our rights and the rights of others;

Managing user registrations:

- We will process your Personal Data by managing your user account for the purpose of performing the contract with you according to any applicable terms of service;

Handling contact and user support requests:

- If you fill out a “Contact Me” web form, request user support, or if you contact us by other means, we will process your Personal Data for the performance of our contract with you and to the extent it is necessary for the purpose of our legitimate interests to fulfill your request and communicate with you;

Managing event registrations and attendance:

- We will process your Personal Data to plan and host the event or webinar, including related communication with you, on basis of the performance of our contract with you and to the extent it is necessary for the purpose of our legitimate interests to fulfill your request and communicate with you;

Managing payments:

- If you have provided financial information, we will process your respective Personal Data to check the financial qualifications and collect payments to the extent this is necessary for completing transaction with you under the contract entered with you;

Developing and improving our websites:

- We will process your Personal Data to analyze trends, track your usage of our websites and interactions with emails to the extent this is necessary for our legitimate interests to develop and improve our websites and to provide our users with more relevant and interesting content;

Managing office visitors:

- We will process your Personal Data for security reasons, to register who visited our offices and who signed the non-disclosure agreement that visitors may be required to sign.

Displaying personalized advertisements and content:

- We will process your Personal Data to conduct marketing research, advertise to you, provide personalized information about us on and off our websites, and other personalized content based upon your activities and interests to the extent it is necessary for our legitimate interests to advertise our websites or, where necessary, to the extent you have provided your prior separate consent (please also view "Your rights relating to your Personal Data" below to learn how you can control how your Personal Data is processed by Treefrog for marketing purposes);

Sending marketing communications:

- We will process your Personal Data to send you marketing information, product recommendations and other non-transactional communications (e.g., marketing newsletters, New modules, discount offers, or push notifications) about us, including information about our products, promotions or events as necessary for our legitimate interests to conduct direct marketing or to the extent you have provided your prior separate consent (please also view "Your rights relating to your Personal Data" section below to learn how you can control how your Personal Data is processed by Treefrog for marketing purposes);

Complying with legal obligations:

- We will process your Personal Data when cooperating with public and government authorities, courts or regulators in accordance with our legal obligations under applicable laws to the extent this requires the processing or disclosure of Personal Data to protect our rights, and is necessary for our legitimate interests to protect against misuse or abuse of our websites, to protect personal

property or safety, to pursue remedies available to us and limit our damages, to comply with a judicial proceedings, court order or legal process, and/or to respond to lawful requests.

Where we need to collect and process Personal Data by law, or under a contract we have entered into with you and you fail to provide that required Personal Data when requested, then we may not be able to perform the contracted services. Certain of our Foundation Platform Software and Websites require some personal information to perform the security and contact functions required by the software and services to function.

Who do we share Personal Data with?

We may share your Personal Data with the following recipients:

- Our contracted service providers which provide services such as IT and system administration, Web Services hosting, credit card processing and customer support;
- If you use our websites to register for an event or webinar organized by Us, we may share your Personal Data with our contracted affiliate (event organizer) to the extent this is required on the basis of the contract with you to process your registration and ensure your participation in the event; in such case, our affiliate will process the relevant Personal Data as a separate controller and will provide you with further information on the processing of your Personal Data, where required.
 - If you do not wish for your information to be shared, you may choose not to opt-in via event registration or elect not to have your badge scanned at our events;
- In individual cases we may also share Personal Data with professional advisers acting as processors or joint controllers including lawyers, bankers, auditors and insurers based in countries in which we operate who provide consultancy, banking, legal, insurance and accounting services;
- We may also share your Personal Data with other affiliates within the Treefrog corporate group to the extent this is necessary to fulfill a request you have submitted via our websites, or for customer support, marketing, technical operations and account management purposes.
- If we are involved in a merger or reorganization, sell all or a portion of our business, our assets or stock are acquired by another company, we may transfer some or all of your Personal Data to such third party. In accordance with applicable laws, we will use reasonable efforts to notify you of any such transfer of Personal Data to an unaffiliated third party as processing of your Personal Data will be required for the purposes set out in "Purposes for which we process Personal Data and on which legal bases" section above.
- Any Personal Data or other information you choose to submit in communities, forums, blogs, or chat rooms on our websites may be read, collected, and/or used by others who visit these forums, depending on your account settings.

International transfer of information collected

Your Personal Data may be collected, transferred to and stored by us in the United States and or the United Kingdom or other Contracted affiliate companies depending on your usage of our Foundation Platform and Websites, and also by the configuration settings you choose when implementing the Foundation Platform Software Services.

Therefore, your Personal Data may be processed outside the European Economic Area (EEA), for example Bermuda, or the British Virgin Islands, Outside of the United States, and possibly in countries which are not subject to an adequacy decision by the European Commission and which may not provide for the same level of data protection in the USA or EEA. In this event, we will ensure that such recipient offers an adequate level of protection, for instance by entering into standard contractual clauses for the transfer of data as approved by the European Commission (Art. 46 GDPR), or we will ask you for your prior consent to such international data transfers.

Where possible the Foundation Platform Software is hosted in the Region in which You choose.

Children

Our websites are not intended for children. If you are under the age of 16 you cannot use our Foundation Platform websites or applications without express written consent from your parent or legal guardian. We do not knowingly collect Personal Data from children under the age of 16. If you are a parent or guardian and believe your child has provided us with Personal Data without your consent, please contact us as described in the "Contacting Us" section below and we will take steps to delete such Personal Data from our systems.

How long do we keep your Personal Data?

We may retain your Personal Data for a period of time consistent with the original purpose of collection (see "Purposes for which we process Personal Data and on what legal basis" section above). We determine the appropriate retention period for Personal Data on the basis of the amount, nature, and sensitivity of your Personal Data, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure, and whether we can achieve the purposes of the processing through other means, as well as the applicable legal requirements (such as applicable statutes of limitation).

After expiry of the retention periods, your Personal Data will be deleted. If there is any information that we are unable, for technical reasons, to delete entirely from our systems, we will put in place appropriate measures to prevent any further use of the data.

Your rights relating to your Personal Data

You have certain rights regarding your Personal Data, subject to local data protection laws. These may include the following rights:

- to access your Personal Data held by us (right to access);
- to rectify inaccurate Personal Data and ensure it is complete (right to rectification);
- to erase/delete your Personal Data to the extent permitted by other legal obligations (right to erasure; right to be forgotten);
- to restrict our processing of your Personal Data (right to restriction of processing);
- to transfer your Personal Data to another controller to the extent possible (right to data portability);
- to object to any processing of your Personal Data carried out on the basis of our legitimate interests (right to object). Where we process your Personal Data for direct marketing purposes or share it with third parties for their own direct marketing purposes, you can exercise your right to object at any time to such processing without having to provide any specific reason for such objection;
- not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects ("Automated Decision-Making"); Automated Decision-Making currently does not take place on our Applications or websites;
- to the extent we base the collection, processing and sharing of your Personal Data on your consent, to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on such consent before its withdrawal.
- Your right to restrict, remove or inhibit your personal information usage will in certain circumstances restrict the ability of Treefrog to provide the service. In such cases you will be informed of this prior to the removal of the service.

How to exercise your rights

To exercise your rights, please contact Us in accordance with the "Contacting Us" section below. We try to respond to all legitimate requests within thirty (30) days and will contact you if we need additional information from you in order to honor your request. Occasionally it may take us longer than thirty (30) days, taking into

account the complexity and number of requests we receive. If you are a User of the Foundation Platform under a Subscription License, we recommend you contact your company's system administrator for assistance in correcting or updating your information.

In addition, if you have registered for an account with us, you may generally update your user settings, profile, organization's settings or event registration by logging into the applicable website with your username and password and editing your settings or profile. To update your billing information, discontinue your account, and/or request return or deletion of your Personal Data and other information associated with your account, please contact us.

Your preferences for marketing communications

If we process your Personal Data for the purpose of sending you marketing communications, you may manage your receipt of marketing and non-transactional communications from us by clicking on the "unsubscribe" link located on the bottom of our marketing emails, by replying or texting 'STOP' if you receive SMS communications, or by turning off push notifications on our apps on your device. Additionally, you may unsubscribe by contacting Us using the information in the "Contacting Us" section below.

Please note that opting-out of marketing communications does not opt you out of receiving important business communications related to your current relationship with us, such as information about your subscriptions or event registrations, service announcements or security information.

Security

We take precautions including organizational, technical, and physical measures, to help safeguard against accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure of, or access to, the Personal Data we process or use.

While we follow generally accepted standards to protect Personal Data, no method of storage or transmission is 100% secure. You are solely responsible for protecting your password, limiting access to your devices, and signing out of websites after your sessions. If you have any questions about the security of our websites, please contact us via the "Contacting Us" section below.

Google Analytics

Our website uses Google Analytics, a web analysis service of Google, Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043 USA, www.google.com ("Google Analytics" or "Google"). Google Analytics employs cookies that are stored to your computer in order to facilitate an analysis of your use of the www.FoundationPlatform.com site. The information generated by these cookies, such as time, place and frequency of your visits to our site, including your IP address, is transmitted to Google's location in the US and stored there.

In using Google Analytics our website employs the extension "anonymizeIp". In doing so, Google abbreviates and thereby anonymizes your IP address before transferring it from EU/EEA member states. Google uses this information to analyze your use of our site, to compile reports for us on internet activity and to provide other services relating to our website.

Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law or where such third parties process this data on Google's behalf. Google states that it will in never associate your IP address with other data held by Google. You can prevent cookies from being installed by adjusting the settings on your browser software accordingly as noted elsewhere in this Privacy Policy. You should be aware, however, that by doing so you may not be able to make full use of all the functions of our website.

Google Analytics also offers a deactivation add-on for most current browsers that provides you with more control over what data Google can collect on websites you access. The add-on tells the JavaScript (ga.js) used by Google Analytics not to transmit any information about website visits to Google Analytics. However, the browser deactivation add-on offered by Google Analytics does not prevent information from being transmitted to us or to other web analysis services we may engage.

Google Analytics also uses electronic images known as web beacons (sometimes called single pixel gifs) and are used along with cookies to compile aggregated statistics to analyze how our site is used.

For the cases in which personal data is transferred to the US, Google has self-certified pursuant to the EU-US Privacy Shield (<https://www.privacyshield.gov/EU-US-Framework>).

Google as Data Processor

Google operates as a data processor for Google Analytics. This is reflected in our Ads Data Processing Terms, which are available to all Google Analytics customers with direct contracts with Google.

Google Analytics is a data processor under GDPR because Google Analytics collects and processes data on behalf of our clients, pursuant to their instructions. Our customers are data controllers who retain full rights over the collection, access, retention, and deletion of their data at any time. Google's use of data is controlled by the terms of its contract with Google Analytics customers and any settings enabled by customers through the user interface of our product.

Data Processing Terms

The Google Ads Data Processing Terms are meant for businesses established in the territory of a member state of the European Economic Area (EEA) or Switzerland, or that, for other reasons, are subject to the territorial scope of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Changes to this Privacy Statement

We will update this Privacy Statement from time to time to reflect changes in our practices, technology, legal requirements and other factors.
